Kerr+Konnect Update

The Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of the Hill Country in Kerrville presented Kerr+Konnect, the local volunteer based non-profit transportation program with a check for \$2,000 to help them meet a challenge grant from the Community Foundation of the Hill Country. If Kerr+Konnect raises \$10,000 from the community by November, the Foundation will match it with an additional \$10,000.

With an initial operating area covering a 10-mile radius from the Kerr County courthouse, the service area will include Center Point and Ingram. Rides will be scheduled in advance by calling or going to the Kerr+Konnect website. The door to door service will cost \$2 one way or \$4 round-trip.

Kerr+Konnect is scheduled to start transportation assistance for seniors and others in September after more than two years of research, planning and development. The organization received non-profit certification from the Texas Comptroller and tax exempt non-profit status from IRS.

With their gift, the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of the Hill Country challenges other churches in the Kerr County community to support this much needed and well thought out project for the overall enrichment of the Kerrville and Kerr County community.

Hill Country Crisis Council Kids Advocacy Place Needs Your Help

Part of Hill Country Crisis Council is the Kids Advocacy Place where HCCC psychologists conduct **forensic interviews** with the children and their families experiencing **abuse**.

Understandably, children in this situation need to be relaxed and supported. During these forensic interviews, HCCC kindly provides the children with juice boxes and snacks. So far this year more than 200 children have been assisted and HCCC has now run out supplies.


