FROM YOUR MINISTER...

As many of you know we will be holding our annual pledge drive soon. Yes, it is that time again. You will be hearing a lot about this in the upcoming weeks. I wanted to give you an idea of what has been done to prepare for next year's budget.

Andy has met with the Committee Chairs and they have suggested amounts that they will need to continue doing the ministry of the congregation. After that meeting Andy, Linda and I sat down and went over the numbers and we sliced and diced until we came up with a fairly reasonable amount for our little congregation. For the second year in a row I have declined a raise. I did not ask for money to attend conferences and I believe that will help a bit.

The one figure that was brought before the Board as they discussed the budget was the increase in UUA dues. The UUA has increased their suggested donation to \$60 per congregational member plus 7% for the Southern Region. That increase will take us from around \$2,000 to about \$5,000 for 2018. Andy will present the actual numbers when he prepares the budget report. This is a big hit for our small budget which is why we analyzed the numbers so closely.

The other thing that we would like to do is to increase our giving to the five organizations we annually provide donations to. Although we do take the 5th Sunday collection from the congregation and add \$100 from the church budget, it would be nice if we could contribute more. I am very sure that every organization truly appreciates our gift but a few more dollars might be nice.

As we get closer to the actual pledge drive be ready to see it done in a new way. We are hopeful that you appreciate our congregation and will help to keep it moving forward in 2018.
