Workshop Description

What is the story of your life? What do you want others to know? What do you want to be sure to do before you die? These are the questions that form the foundation for our personal stories and odysseys. Our workshop, "From the High Hill: Odyssey Writing for Elders" by Reverend Anne Odin Heller, will engage elders in mining the stories of a lifetime to create a presentation to share with co-congregants, peers, and loved ones. Two weekend retreats—one for preparation, one for presentations— will frame an individual period of remembering, sorting, reflecting, and writing. We will have some fun exercises to help all participants, even those who are nervous about writing, tell their story.

Donna Harrison is a UU lay leader who serves our faith in a variety of ways. She recently completed 6 years of service on the UUA Board of Trustees. During that time she served for two years as the Vice-Moderator of the Unitarian Universalist Association. Donna serves as secretary on the board of UBarU and has served for 8 years as the codirector of the senior high camp at UBarU.
