
Transportation Study Group UPDATE

Led by Karen Burkett, the Transportation Group, a subcommittee of the Social Justice/Outreach Committee has made headway in making this initiative viable for the Kerrville and surrounding communities.

Initiated in September 2015, the Transportation Study Group has evolved to include representatives from church social services, community medical services, veterans' services, Dietert Center, BCFS and other non-profits organizations. Members are working toward developing and implementing public transportation services in Kerrville ranging from door-to-door senior transportation with volunteer drivers to, potentially, a traditional bus system serving students, employees, seniors, families and all others who don't or can't drive. Clearly this ambitious goal will be met slowly and in incremental steps, beginning with a small and singularly focused project.

At the Study Group's June meeting, work began on selecting members for a Planning Council to be comprised of community leaders who have an interest in the development of an efficient and effective transportation system for Kerrville. Secondly, a date in mid-August was set for a community forum to gather information regarding citizens' transportation needs.

There will be no Transportation Study Group meeting in July, and no regular meeting in August. Currently the group is preparing for the community-wide Transportation Focus Forum on Monday August 16, 5:30-7pm at Dietert Center, 451 Guadalupe St, Kerrville.



Everyone is urged to attend and share ideas for the future of Kerrville - especially for those with lower incomes and those who struggle for jobs, health, recovery and homelessness because they don't have access to affordable and reliable transportation.

Monthly meetings are customarily held the third Wednesday at 1:30pm in the BCFS Kerrville Resource Center on East Main Street.

Welcoming Congregation

There was a shooting in Orlando during the week before Father's Day. Many people were murdered and many others were injured in a gay nightclub. I spoke about this in my sermon on Father's Day and I mentioned that I would like to see our congregation become a Welcoming Congregation.

Churches are not always very friendly to people who identify as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual or Transgendered (LGBT). In fact, many churches will ask you to leave if they find out. For the last 25 years, the Unitarian Universalist Association has worked to make sure that people who identify as LGBT are welcomed and made a part of our church communities. Many congregations are identified on the UUA website as welcoming congregations which allow members of the LGBT community to know that there is a place where they can worship without fear. I would like to see our congregation become one of those congregations.

I have heard members of our congregation say that we are already welcoming and indeed we are. However, if I were traveling from another state and didn't know this wonderful little congregation in Kerrville, I would not know that.

I will be presenting a plan to the Board in July which will include some educational opportunities for the members of our congregation. If the Board approves moving forward on this, I will be asking for your help in making our congregation one of the hundreds of congregations in the United States identified as welcoming.
