

The first was Samuel "Sam" Wright who was Dwight's supervising minister when he went to Starr King School for the Ministry in Berkley CA. The names of so many people I know or of went rolling on. What a gift I have been given as a result of being a part of this movement. The gift of reasonable discourse, love and appreciation of each other in our differences and the food of music for my soul.
